

ICC Evaluation Service (ICC-ES) Seeks Interested Individuals to Serve on its Evaluation Committee

The ICC Evaluation Service (ICC-ES) seeks to fill an opening on the ICC-ES Evaluation Committee. The Evaluation Committee plays a critical role in reviewing and evaluating proposed ICC-ES acceptance criteria developed by staff for building products.

Qualified candidates must represent a jurisdiction enforcing building regulation and possess experience in fire prevention and plan review. The committee considers input from building industry professionals and academic experts, presented during public hearings or in written form. Committee decisions are based on whether sufficient evidence demonstrates that the proposed acceptance criteria meet the needs of building officials in enforcing applicable codes and regulations.

The Evaluation Committee meets at least three times per year via online sessions, each lasting between half a day to a full day, with the possibility of one in-person meeting per year, as well as additional conference calls and web-based meetings and needed. Appointees are expected to participate fully in all scheduled committee meetings.

Individuals interested in being considered for the Evaluation Committee should submit the attached application.

ICC-ES performs technical evaluations of alternative building materials, components, design and methods of construction. Manufacturers rely on ICC-ES evaluation reports to help bring innovative building products to market more efficiently and to demonstrate compliance to the applicable codes. The evaluation process culminates with the issuance of technical reports that directly address code compliance and are extremely useful to both regulatory agencies and building product manufacturers. Agencies use evaluation reports to help determine compliance with codes and building regulations; manufacturers use reports as evidence their products meet code requirements and warrant regulatory approval. ICC-ES evaluation reports are public documents, available free of charge at www.icc-es.org, to building officials, manufacturers, contractors, architects, engineers and anyone with an interest in the building industry.
